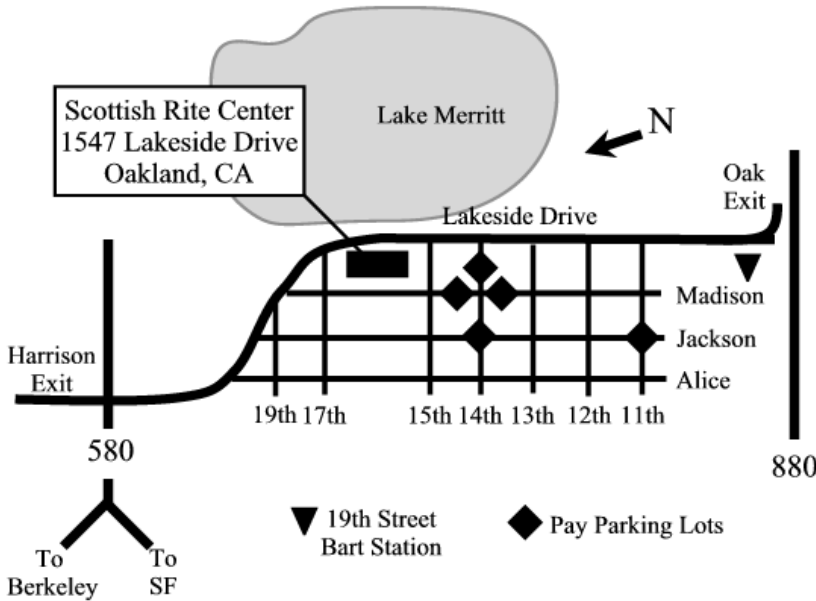

From Highway 580

- ◆ Take the Harrison Street Exit, turn down hill
- ◆ Stay in the left lane and curve onto Lakeside for two blocks
- ◆ Turn right onto Madison
- ◆ Park on the street or in the Scottish Rite Center parking lot (usually fills very early) or in one of the pay lots

From Highway 880

- ◆ Take Oak Street Exit
- ◆ Stay on Oak as it becomes Lakeside
- ◆ Turn left onto 14th for pay lots, or stay on Lakeside for street parking
